Spandex (elastane) yarns, LYCRA® and ELASPAN® yarn, raw, white and black. Note: Various tested fibres may contain more than 0,1 % (but max. 1.5 %) of DMAc and have to undergo further industrial production stages (heat process in wet or dry stage is preferred, but also other steps are possible). Afterwards new tests for the presence of DMAc (max. 0,1 %) are obligatory.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 6, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 6 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by 0EKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
